Overview

U.S. Senator Robert P. Casey, Jr. has established the Veterans Internship in his Washington, D.C. office. This internship, open to college students and recent graduates with a Pennsylvania background, is an opportunity for students to gain access and exposure to the activities of the United States Senate. In addition to assisting staff with legislative assignments, students will also assist appropriate legislative staff on specific veterans and servicemember issues and special projects. This position will allow the student to offer expertise and first hand experiences that will benefit the constituents of Pennsylvania. Students are also encouraged to gain college credit for their experience if applicable.

Eligibility Requirements

Each applicant:

- Should have a demonstrated interest in public service and interest learning about the legislative process.
- Must be able to work and learn in diverse settings.
- Should have solid scholastic achievement, demonstrated leadership ability, interest in public policy, and strong writing skills.
- Should have a Pennsylvania background.
- Must be a servicemember or a veteran of the US Armed Services.
