



THE ARMY RESERVE MINUTEMAN SCHOLARSHIP

2024 - 2025 CAMPAIGN

The Minuteman Campaign is a US Cadet Command initiative to offer Guaranteed Reserve Forces Duty (GRFD) Scholarships to candidates that self-select for service in a Reserve Component.

SCHOLARSHIP OVERVIEW

- The Minuteman campaign awards 2-, 2.5-, 3-, 3.5-, 4-year scholarships.
- Public, Non-resident or private institution rates authorized.
- They must be academically aligned to start and end the scholarship by graduation date and commission.
- Graduate degrees eligible.
- All scholarships are based on available funding.

How to Apply:

- Meet all scholarship qualifications
- Seek a nomination and interview from one of the following resources:

 - USAR Major Subordinate Command Commander

BENEFITS

- Covers full tuition and fees OR room and board (\$10,000 per year)
- Monthly \$420 Cadet stipend (freshmen-senior year)
- Annual \$1,200 book stipend
- Earn E-5 drill pay upon contracting
- Guaranteed commission in the Army Reserve with an eight-year service obligation

REQUIREMENTS

- Minimum test scores: GT/ASVAB = 110, SAT/ACT = TBP
- 2.5 Cumulative GPA
- Official college/university acceptance letter
- Currently Enlisted or eligible to enlist
- Must be a U.S. citizen or U.S. National
- Meet physical fitness requirements
- Between age of 17-28
- GRFD MM scholarship recipients cannot compete for active duty
- Eligible to participate in the Simultaneous Membership Program (SMP) with an Army Reserve unit
