Fort Indiantown Gap	<p>This funding is needed to support the Access Control Points project approved in FY21. This project will complete the security and infrastructure protection requirements for the Access Control Point construction on the East and West of Fort Indiantown Gaps access routes. The completion of the entire project will be complete with this funding. Additional funding is required to complete the fencing project that supports the security of the FTIG Garrison facilities. The scope of work for this project is a follow-on contract to the original contract. This new scope of work includes the construction of High Security Perimeter Fence at West Access Control Point. The cost estimate for this project is based on competitive bidding between approximately six contractors. The project is based on March 2022 construction commencement and an August 30, 2022 construction completion for a total 180-day construction schedule (6 months). The midpoint of construction is June 01, 2022. Productivity is included at 100%, with no anticipated lost work time due to base operations.</p>	Annville PA	\$3,265
