To meet needs across Pennsylvania, Senator Casey secured funding for community projects in the FY24 federal spending bill. The funding will go directly to local governments, non-profit and community organizations, and more. Projects are listed below by region.

Southeastern Pennsylvania and the Lehigh Valley

Project Title: Children's Crisis Treatment Center in Philadelphia

Recipient: HACE Amount: \$1,500,000 County: Philadelphia

Project Description: This project will advance the development of a new child and

family outpatient mental health clinic in the heart of Philadelphia's Latino

community in North Philadelphia.

Project Title: Historic Carman Gardens Health Center

Recipient: North 10 Amount: \$1,000,000 County: Philadelphia

Project Description: This project will convert a former roller-skating rink into a

full-service health and wellness center in the Hunting Park-East Tioga

neighborhood of North Philadelphia. This will generate 20,000 square feet of space for health services providers in the community. Senator Casey secured this

funding in partnership with Representative Boyle.

Project Title: Lamberton School Improvements

Project Description: This project will construct a new playground at the Robert E. Lamberton Elementary School in Philadelphia's Overbrook Park neighborhood. This playground will ensure that local students have access to a safe place to play and learn outdoors. Senator Casey secured this funding in partnership with

Senator Fetterman and Representative Evans.

Project Title: Philadelphia Healthy and Safe Schools (PHASeS) program

Project Description: This project will work to increase tree coverage near Philadelphia schools to mitigate the urban heat island effect and improve air quality for students. Senator Casey secured this funding in partnership with

Representative Evans.

Project Description: This project will construct a community room to serve residents of the 17th Street Revitalization Project, a new construction

development with 36 quality, affordable housing units for extremely low-income

individuals.

Project Description: This project will make repairs and improvements to Rowan House, a 26-unit supportive housing complex located in West Philadelphia. Rowan

Project Description: This project will rehabilitate the 26th Street Lift, an important access point to the Philadelphia Navy Yard from South Philadelphia and I-95. This work will ensure that the bridge can continue to serve both commuting workers and passing ships. Senator Casey secured this funding in partnership with Representative Scanlon.
