

Cumberland County District Attorney's Office	This project will expand the forensic services, including traditional and Rapid DNA analyses, of the Cumberland County District Attorney's Office, which maintains and operates an ISO 17025 accredited multi-disciplinary forensic laboratory.	Cumberland County PA	\$284
Hellam Township	Hellam Township seeks funding for UTVs and police vehicles to maintain public safety at Susquehanna Riverland's Park by helping local law enforcement perform active search and rescues with firefighters and EMTs, and control expected traffic.	Hellam Township PA	\$90
