The purpose of this letter is to request a recipient change for a Fiscal Year 2024 Congressionally Directed Spending project in the Senate Transportation, Housing and Urban Development, and Related Agencies appropriations bill, listed below. I certify that neither I nor my immediate family has a pecuniary interest in any of the Congressionally Directed Spending items that I have requested, consistent with the requirements of paragraph 9 of Rule XLIV of the Standing Rules of the Senate. I certify that the entity for which I have requested Congressionally Directed Spending is not a for-profit entity.

The reason for this necessary correction is a shift in site management and the site redevelopment plan. The eligible blight remediation work is still scheduled to take place as indicated in the original project purpose and meets the CDBG national objective of eliminating blight.
